

CPA Compliance - Client Cheque-List

Ensure your cheques include the CPA mandatory cheque changes effective June 30, 2007:

- Consecutive micr encoding now mandatory
- Minimum length of a cheque is 6.25"
- Maximum depth of a cheque is 3.75"
- Standardized location/size/format of date field*
- Standardized location/size of amount field*
- Mandatory 5/8" clear band for MICR
- Pantographs cannot be visible on images captured from the original cheque – We cannot be responsible for CPA compliance on files or film not provided by Print Key.
- Standardized location/size/format for the endorsement line and teller stamp on the back of cheques
- Backprinting must comply with the maximum print contrast signal for informational printing. We cannot be responsible for CPA compliance of files or film not provided by The Print Key.
- The phrase "back/endos" is to print 1" from aligning edge on back of cheque – ASK ABOUT OUR STANDARD BACKPRINTING.

*These changes to the standards will involve modifying your software output to CPA standards.
